ACT

ON AMENDMENTS TO THE HRVATSKA BANKA ZA OBNOVU I RAZVITAK ACT

Article 1

In the Hrvatska banka za obnovu i razvitak Act ("Narodne novine", the Official Gazette of the Republic of Croatia No. 138/2006), Article 17 paragraph 1, the word "nine" shall be replaced by the word "ten".

Paragraph 2 shall be amended to read as follows:

"(2) The Supervisory Board consists of six Ministers in the Government of the Republic of Croatia, of which the Minister in charge of finance, the Minister in charge of the economy and the Minister in charge of regional development and EU funds shall be the obligatory members of the Supervisory Board, whereas the remaining three ministers shall be appointed to the Supervisory Board by the Government of the Republic of Croatia from among the Ministers in charge of tourist industry, agriculture, environmental protection, construction industry or entrepreneurship and trade."

Article 2

This Act shall enter into force on the eighth day after the day of its publication in the Official Gazette.
